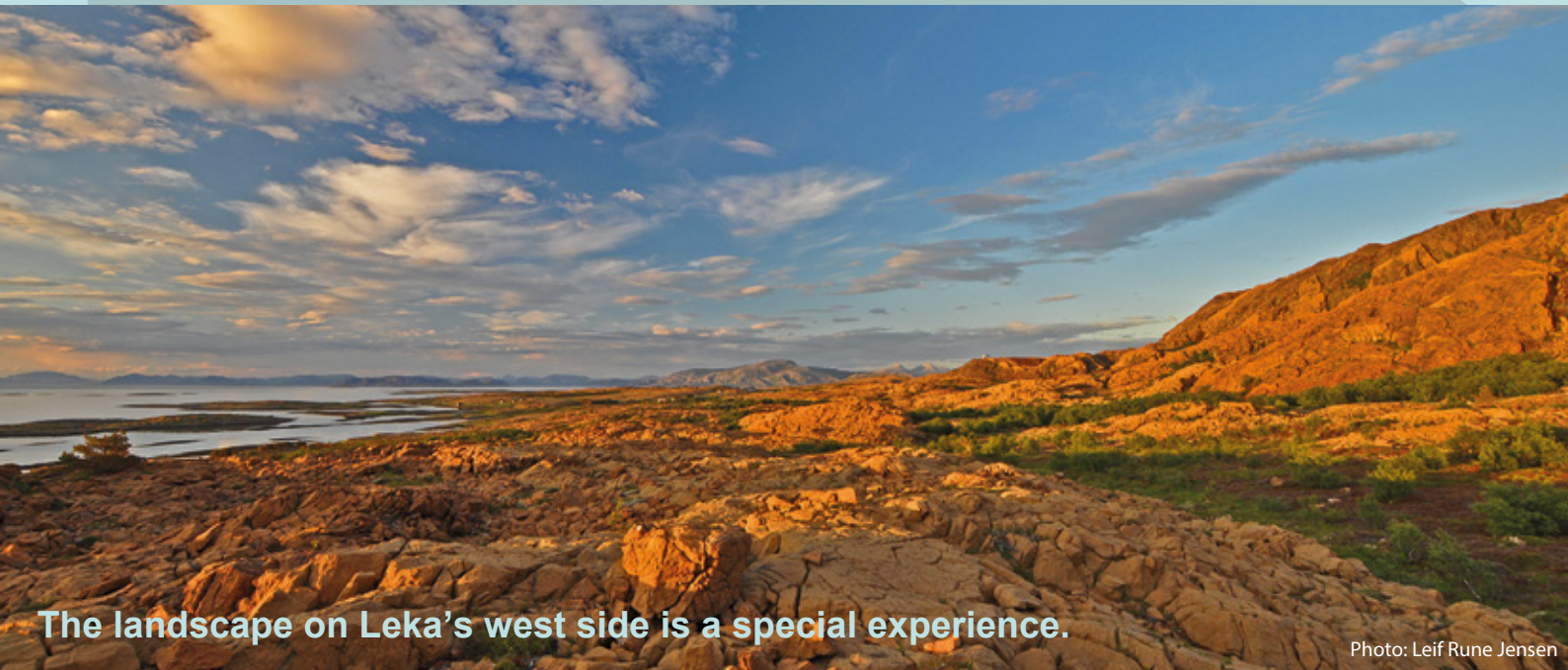




Leka – Top 5

Top 5 on Leka

- 1 **Skeisnesset cultural heritage trail:** Prepared trails among beautiful well preserved heather. Traces of humans from the Stone Age until present day including Stone Age homesteads and burial mounds, geological trail, rich plant life, and open stone cottage. Information boards.
- 2 **Ørnerovet:** The 5th of June, 1932, little Svanhild, 3 1/2 years old was taken by an eagle and left on a mountain ledge. The place she was found is indicated high up in the mountain side, and can be seen from the main road.
- 3 **Leka Steinsenter:** Exhibition of stones from Leka and other locations. Information about the Leka-Geology.

01.07-31.07: Tue/Thu/Sat 12:00 - 14:00
- 4 **The cave paintings** in the Solsemcave was the first to be discovered in North Europe. Join in on a guided tour (1,5 - 2 h.).
- 5 **Walks on Leka:** There are more than 50 waymarked trails on Leka. At the ferry landings at Skei and Gutvik, you will find descriptions of the routes. **Tour suggestions:**
 - 1 **Skeisnesset:** 20 information posts and numerous exciting trails – including the Geology Trail. Basic and short walks.
 - 2 **Herlaugsløypa Trail:** Day-trip – round-trip hike in the Leka Mountains. Opportunities to visit several mountaintops along the way. For experienced hikers.
 - 3 **Støypet:** A journey into Leka's geology. You walk on rock types from the deepest part of the oceanic crust.
